### ADDENDUM No. 4

Issued: 18th February, 2013

At the NKC meeting held on the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2013, the following was approved and is effective immediately.

1. Change to rule 16.05(c) 1).

16.05(c) 1). Timed qualifying Sessions:

For events or specific races that require timed qualifying to determine grid positions (other than State or National Championship events), the organizers may program a minimum of one or a maximum of two timed qualifying sessions per class. Each programmed timed qualifying session must allow competitors a reasonable time to complete a minimum of three (3) timed laps and shall be no more than **ten (10)** minutes in duration.

2. Change to rule 16.05(d) 1) to read;

16.05(d) 1) Technical Infringement During an Event:

When a competitor fails to record a time **during timed qualifying** for any reason other than through the fault of the organizers, the driver will be issued a time of the slowest lap time from that **class**, plus one second. Action will be taken by the issue of a Penalty Notification Form, which will be issued without an Officials Hearing and signed by at least one Steward and the Chief Timing Officer (Judge of Fact).

A complaint / appeal cannot be lodged against this action.
